### SAYORNIS FLYCATCHERS (PHOEBES) SUMMARY

#### **▶** Eastern Phoebe

- ▶ Very common in woodlands
- Almost constantly wagging tail downward
- Yellow wash on belly
- Darkest on head and face
- Gray smudge on sides of breast
- ▶ Diffuse demarcation on underside

#### ▶ Say's Phoebe

- Peach undertail coverts, sometimes a wash on belly
- Pale gray back & head
- Black tail

#### Black Phoebe

- ▶ Black head & chest
- White belly
- ► Sharp demarcation between white belly & black chest

































